



Shop Kiddo! Whole Foods Scrip Card

Add Kiddo! to your grocery list....

Kiddo! is excited to add another option to our Shop Kiddo! program. In addition to eScrip and Mill Valley Market's Shop & Give Program, you can purchase \$100 scrip cards directly from Kiddo! We receive a 4% rebate on the purchase of each card. It costs you nothing yet raises funds for Kiddo! programs.

Whole Foods Scrip Cards are just like cash and can be used at any Whole Foods store and on any item. The Miller Ave. store is making the 4% donation to Kiddo! so we encourage you to shop there, but scrip cards will be honored at all Whole Food stores. Purchase as often and as much as you like!

How the program works

1. Place your order via the website, the Kiddo! office and/or at your school's designated purchase/pick-up day.
2. Your scrip card order can be picked up at the Kiddo! office or on your school's designated purchase/pick-up day.
3. The scrip cards are in \$100 denominations. There is no minimum or maximum order – in fact, we encourage you to order many cards on a regular basis!
4. Please make your check out to Shop Kiddo!.

Q&A

Q: Do I receive the full value of the \$100 scrip card?

A: Yes! When you purchase Whole Foods scrip cards, you receive the full value of the card. For example, if you purchase \$200 worth of cards, you receive the full \$200 value. The donation to Kiddo! comes from the Whole Foods store on Miller Ave.

Q: How often can I place an order?

A: You may place orders as often as you would like but we encourage you to order a month's worth of cards at a time.

Q: Why don't you accept credit cards?

A: We do not accept credit card payment because the credit card transaction would significantly reduce the contribution Kiddo! receives.

Q: What is my school's designated day for placing and picking up orders?

A: This is a new program and we are still organizing the school site schedule. Stay tuned for more information.

Q: How often can I order?

A: You can place an order at any time via the online form and in the Kiddo! office. We are currently working on scheduling a designated day for purchase/pick-up at each of the elementary schools.

Q: When do I bring a check?

A: Bring a check when you pick up your order.

Q: I don't go to the school very often. Can my child pick up my scrip order?

A: Yes, but they must have a check in the amount of the purchase.

Q: Do other grocery stores support Kiddo!?

A: Yes! Register your credit, ATM and Safeway Club card at www.eScrip.com and a percentage of every purchase you make using your registered cards at participating merchants like Safeway, Paradise Foods, Mollie Stones and others is donated to Kiddo!. Mill Valley Market contributes 2% of your purchase when you say "Kiddo!" at the beginning of your transaction.

Q: Why are you encouraging me to shop at the Miller Avenue Whole Foods store?

A: The Miller Ave. store is the store that is making the 4% contribution to Kiddo! However, the scrip cards are good at all Whole Foods stores.

Q: Can I give scrip cards as gifts?

A: Yes! Scrip cards make great gifts for teachers, babysitters, family, friends etc...

Q: Do you have to have a child in the Mill Valley School District to purchase scrip cards?

A: No, anyone can purchase scrip cards through Kiddo!

Q: If I don't use the scrip card at the Miller Ave. Whole Foods will Kiddo! still receive the 4% donation?

A: Yes. Because we purchase the cards from the Miller Ave. store, they are the one making the donation. You can use the scrip at ANY Whole Foods store.

Q: Can I buy \$50 worth of scrip cards?

A: No. At this time, we are only offering cards in \$100 denominations.

Q: Can I use more than one scrip card per purchase at the store?

A: Yes. Think of scrip cards like cash. You can use as many cards as it takes to pay the bill.

Q: What if my purchase is larger than what I have left on my card?

A: You can pay the remaining balance by cash, check or credit card.

Q: What happens if I lose my card?

A: Kiddo! is not responsible for lost cards. Scrip is like cash! Do not lose it!
